2.1 Install

2.1.1 Via PyPi.org

Use this piece of code:

```
pip install thelatinlibrary
```

2.1.2 Via GitHub

Use this piece of code:

```
pip install git+https://github.com/hearot/thelatinlibrary.git
```

2.1.3 Downloading files

In primis (from Latin, “firstable”), **clone** the repository:

```
git clone https://github.com/hearot/thelatinlibrary.git
```

Then, change directory:

```
cd thelatinlibrary
```

And finally, install the **package**:

```
sudo python setup.py install
```

2.2 Example

```
import thelatinlibrary

authors = thelatinlibrary.get_authors()

for author in authors:
    print(author, author.works())

caesar = thelatinlibrary.get_author_by_name("caesar")
print(caesar.works())
```
